
#### **President's Letter**

Bob Stafford has generously offered his time to take our pictures. He will be set up half hour before each meeting to capture the magic. Say, "Cheese!"



# Wine, Chocolate, & Friends...That's a Good Time!



Zonta Zing #3 was hosted by Lisa Hulbert and husband, Mike. The event was a wine-tasting party that provided an opportunity to sample seven different wines and listen to their "stories". The storyteller was Angela Garcia of Wines for Humanity.

Reds and whites, dry to sweet, with a few nuts and chocolates in between



gave all the guests an opportunity to sample wines from around the world and learn how to best appreciate them using the "Five S's" of wine tasting: sight, swirl, smell, savor, swallow. At the beginning of the evening

everyone was decorously sipping their samples and chatting quietly. By the third round, the volume began to rise and sippers shared wine they didn't care for with others who liked it. At the end of the presentation, Angela's message was sometimes lost in the din and laughter.

Angela shared her knowledge of the wines we were tasting and explained how different grapes at different stages of development create different wines. Did you know that Dom Perignon, the Benedictine monk who was the cellar master at his abbey and whose name is synonymous fine wine, invented the wire cage

that covers corks in wine bottles? He did that to keep the fermentation process from causing corks to explode from bottles. Angela supplied

several stories like this as she poured each wine and passed around sugared nuts and Dove chocolates.

One of the side benefits of hosting a Wines for Humanity party is that a portion of the purchases from the party is donated to local charities that work for the prevention of homelessness in families with children. It's a great way to share the camaraderie of friends, learn a little bit along the way, and help the community all in one evening.
