Volunteer/Host Information

Considerations before the Homewalk:

- **Bring your Smile and Holiday Cheer!** Please wear Holiday or Business Attire.
- **Wear comfortable shoes**, you will be on your feet all afternoon. We are not allowed to sit on the homeowner's furniture. (If it is wet, snowy or muddy make sure you have a clean pair of shoes).
- **Bring warm outdoor clothes** as 1-2 Zontians are needed outside for shoes/tickets/talking points.
- **Eat lunch before arriving**, we are not allowed to eat or chew gum in the homes. **If you bring a water bottle, please keep it out of site.**
- **Please fill out and bring with you the Volunteer/Host Form** (*See below*).

Day of Homewalk

- **Arrive at 12:15 noon** Put your coat, boots and purse in the designated closet.
- **Put on your name badge** (Provided by the House Lead) and sign-in.
- The House Lead will give you a **tour of the Home** and show you the **traffic pattern** and the **host locations**.
- **Talking Points** about the home will be given to you. Please stick with the information provided because we have had problems in the past with inaccurate information being shared with visitors.
- **Garlands** will block off the areas where we are not allowed.
- A host will be assigned a **counter** to keep track of the number of visitors who visit the home each day. The visitor count to be texted to Annie on each hour.
- **Front Door Position** - Responsibilities as follows:
 1. Welcome visitors. Share any **talking points** for outdoor spot.
 2. **Shoes must be carried in a bag.** Visitors will remove their shoes on the front porch before entering the home. (Booties are available for those who need to keep their shoes on)
 3. **Check off the appropriate house (the legend) on each ticket** as visitors enter. Everyone over the age of 1yr must have a ticket. **Tickets will be available at the door for \$25.**
 4. If someone asks to pick up tickets they purchased online check the **Will Call List** for their info and notify **Annie Bieneman (847) 596-1054** that you have given the ticket(s) out.
 5. Crowd control may become an issue. The general rule of thumb is **35 people in a home at a time.**

Remember –

No photos nor video are allowed.

Visitors are not allowed to have food, sit on furniture, nor touch items in the home. The Host at the exit should encourage visitors to visit the Rest Stop.
