- 1. Midland County Drug Court Offer a collaborative judicial effort, comprehensive case management and rehabilitation of individuals with substance abuse. Request is for the full 1,140.00 for recovery, coaching, and related services.
- 2. Habitat For Humanity To provide adequate and affordable housing for Midland County families in need. Request is for 1140.00 to go directly towards the cost of construction supplies that will be used during the Women Build Event. In addition, Habitat would like to invite Zonta to participate as volunteers.
- 3. Self Love Beauty SLB is a 501c3 organization that was founded in 2018 with a mission to educate, invest, and impact individuals on the importance of self love and confidence to empower them to be the best version of themselves. Request is for 1140.00 to purchase materials and conduct workshops for women.
- 4. American Legion Auxiliary Post 165 Midland, MI This men and women's organization strives to help those who served and are currently serving in the armed forces. Requesting 1,140.00 to send 2 girls to ALA Girls Nation a week-long program in Lansing teaches women leadership skills, civic responsibility, patriotism and fundamentals of the U.S. Government.
- 5. The Legacy Center Empowers women by helping them develop important life skills and build resiliency one on one tutoring, youth development and drug prevention. Requesting 1,140.00 for Adult Basic Education in low literacy populations gain life changing skills. This has been proven to help avoidance of human sex trafficking as the statistics suggest that 50% are women.
- 6. Life Clinic Community Resource services a 501c3 a 30 years of service agency for women to improve maternal health and infant safety by providing free and confidential early prenatal care and referrals, pregnancy and parenting education, and maternal support. Requesting 1,140.00 which will help 20 women this year to achieve health equity in Midland.
- 7. Helping Hands Dental Clinic HHDC provides dental care for low income women who have Medicaid insurance. There are no public or private dentists that accept Medicaid dental insurance. Requesting 1,140.00 to pay \$3.00 co pays for each visit. One third of women they see are disabled in one way or another.
- 8. Young Lives is a branch of Young Life that provides outreach to mentor teen moms. It encourages mothers to finish high school, obtain further education, provide positive role models, connect them with local resources, empower them to be successful mothers by offering educational and social activities. Most of young clients are at poverty income level, have incurred abuse and have few positive role models in their life. Requesting 1,140.00 to cover expenses for community outings, club food, leadership training resources, and camp expenses.
- 9. Family & Children Services Since 1925 FCS has provided quality counseling, education, and support services designed to nurture family relationships and enhance the well being of individuals in our community. Requesting 1,140.00 to assist them in making services available to women. They are unique in the way that they turn no one away policy regardless of age, presenting concern, ability to pay, or any other factor.
- 10. Community Mental Health Services for Central Michigan serves people with severe and persistent mental illness and intellectual/developmental disabilities along with co-occurring substance abuse disorder. Requesting 1,140.00 to stock our personal/ feminine hygiene closet, cleaning product closet, and provide gas cards for women to get to and from appointments when needed.
